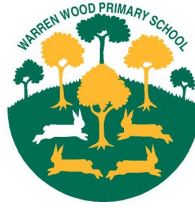

## PTFA Summer Disco

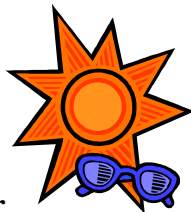
Please collect your children from the disco from the INFANT PLAYGROUND. This is to prevent congestion in Reception.
